Bilgi İşlem Merkezi (BİM) announced that a new licensing strategy had been adapted for MATLAB, and informed that this new type of license included 50 toolboxes (listed in the attached document) and could be used, free of charge, by academicians and students for both educational and research purposes. Only the requests for additional toolboxes will be taken into consideration by the BAP Committee.

- Procurement of software licensed to our University, and serviced by BİM or University library is not supported by the BAP Committee. The list of software serviced by BİM and University library can be accessed via the BİM website (by clicking the "Bilgisayar Desteği" [Computer Support] sub-menu under the "Hizmetler" [Services] menu) and the Library website (by clicking the "Veritabanları" [Databases] sub-menu under the "Elektronik Servisler" [Electronic Services] menu), respectively. BİM or University library can be contacted for further information.
- BAP can only support requests related to the research activities;
 requests for procurement of software to be used for educational purposes
 are not taken into consideration by the BAP Committee.
